The Truth About Judgment

While talking with Holy Spirit one morning about a situation, which I was involved in, the following teaching was given to me. It is written as I recorded it in my journal.

Don't let others tell you how much you hear. That is a statement of judgment and pride. That is not their responsibility to tell others how well they are doing. That's judgment, don't do it.

The only thing you had a right to say about the Ladies (I offered to pray for 2 sick ladies) was it hurt you that they rejected Me in you, and that you give them to Me and ask Me to bless and keep them. That way you stay clear of all Judgment. I don't allow my warriors to judge anyone unless I tell them to for a special reason.

That is what Peter did to Ananias and Sapphira. That is the Judgment talked about in Isaiah Ch 61:2, and is the only judgment on your part that I allow. Paul did the same thing with Bar-Jesus in Acts 13:6-11.

You must learn this now. I will not allow you to judge people, Period. This is the true place of walking as a Bond Servant. Few will ever really reach this level.

To tell another person about what someone did or didn't do always involves judgment. That is why I call gossip a sin. Don't do it.

To walk in this place with me is the place that My Authority and Power will work through you. This is the place you have been looking for.

Why do you think it is so important that you do not judge? (*I don't know, please tell me.*) Judgment requires you to know the motive and intent of the person. Do you know that? (*How could I?*) That's right, you can't know that. That means your judgment will be wrong. That violates the very premise of My kingdom: Love your neighbor as yourself. Any time you judge, you violate the very foundation of My Kingdom, Agape Love.

Strongs #26 Agape (ag-ah-pay) denotes an undefeatable benevolence and unconquerable goodwill that always seeks the highest good of the other person, no matter what he does. It is the self-giving love that gives freely without asking anything in return, and does not consider the worth of its object. Agape Love is a love by choice. Agape describes the unconditional love God has for the world.

No son, you never have the right to judge any person except yourself. There you are more

likely to judge righteously, and even then you miss it at times.

To walk in My Kingdom, (Righteousness, Peace, and Joy - Romans 14:17), there is no room for judgment of any kind unless I command you to do so. Most will never get to the place of no judgment because pride is too great in the one making the judgment: I'm right and you are wrong. Do you see how sinister this is? The Devil knows how evil pride is and how it stops you from being able to walk in the Kingdom Power that I want you to operate in.

I want you to teach others this but first you must walk it yourself. This is the determining factor as to whether you go deeper into my Kingdom or you stay on the fringes of My Power.

(Lord, what if I see a Demon or a person's sin, how do I handle that without judgment?)

It must always be handled in obedience to Me by a direct word on the issue. (Rhema). This is how My first son did everything and it is how you will function also. If you will talk it over with Me, I will show or tell you what you are to do. Only then are you allowed to do or say anything.

I am always interested in maturing and bringing to freedom My hurting children. If that is your heart also, you will want to see them through My eyes. Then I can show you their heart and use you to help them to be free. Many will not move completely to freedom because of fear of the unknown, but I will take them to as much freedom as they will allow Me to.

Do you want to be involved with Me in that also? (YES Lord!) OK then all judgment must go! This is do-able! Set your heart to do it and I will teach you and help you learn how. This is My desire for you. Love your neighbor as I have loved you!
